

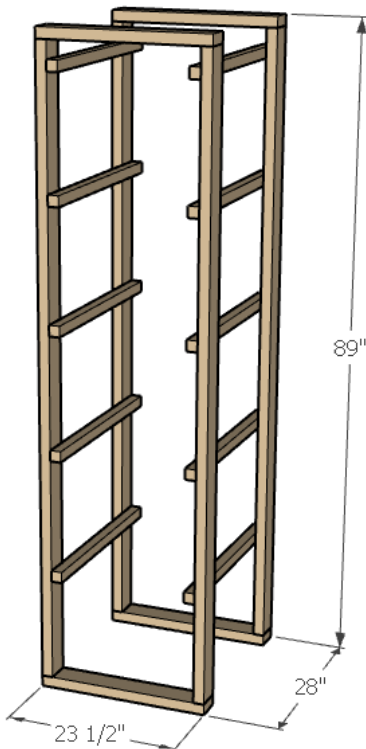


FIX THIS BUILD THAT

DIY Tote Storage Shelves

These tote storage shelves are simple to build and will give you a lot of storage in a small space. They are made to hold 27 gallon storage totes and are made from only 5 2x4s and 3 2x2s for a vertical set of 5 totes. Add more columns and store as many as you want!

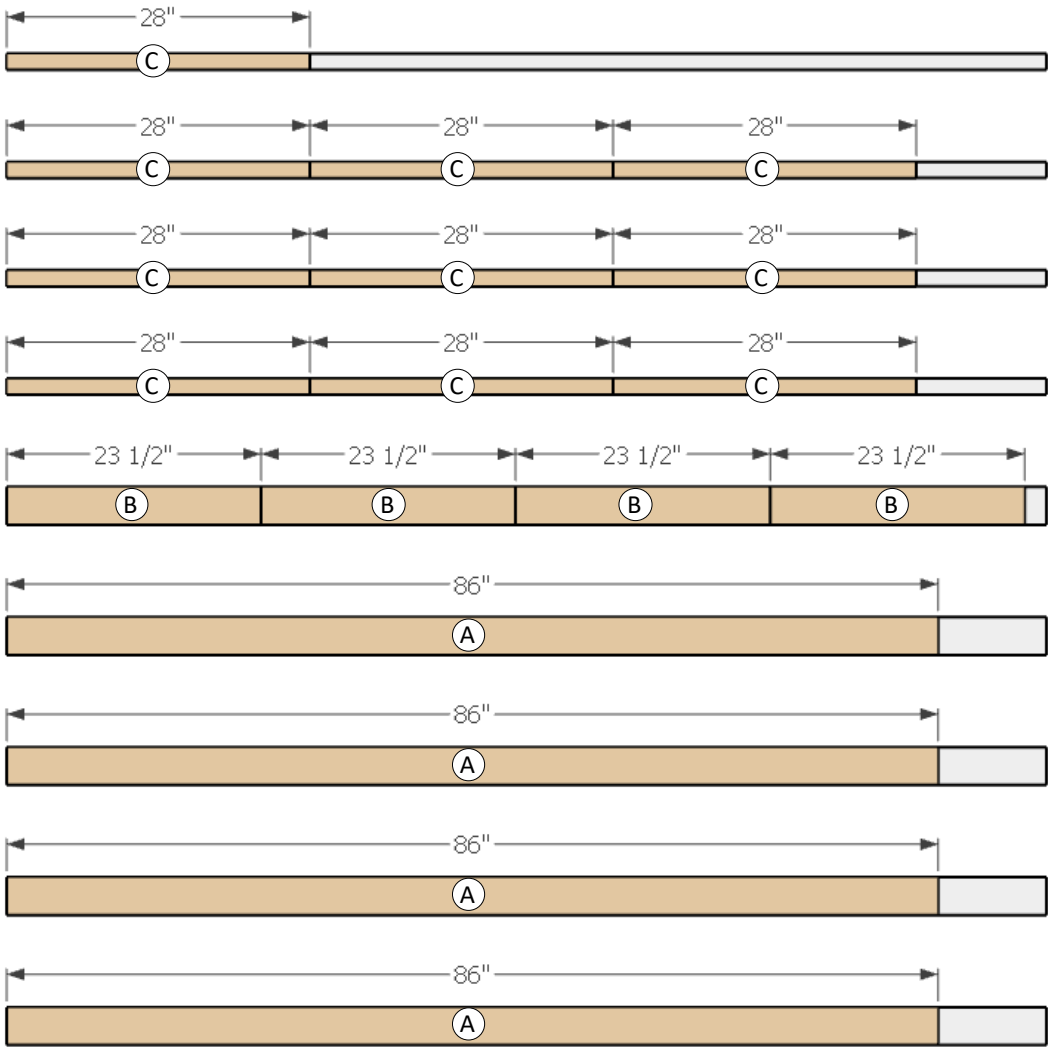

Parts List & Cut List

Part	Description	Qty	Dimensions	Material
A	Frame Leg	4	86" x 3-1/2" x 1-1/2"	Pine 2x4
B	Frame Top/Bottom	4	23-1/2" x 3-1/2" x 1-1/2"	Pine 2x4
C	Rail	10	28" x 1-1/2" x 1-1/2"	Pine 2x2

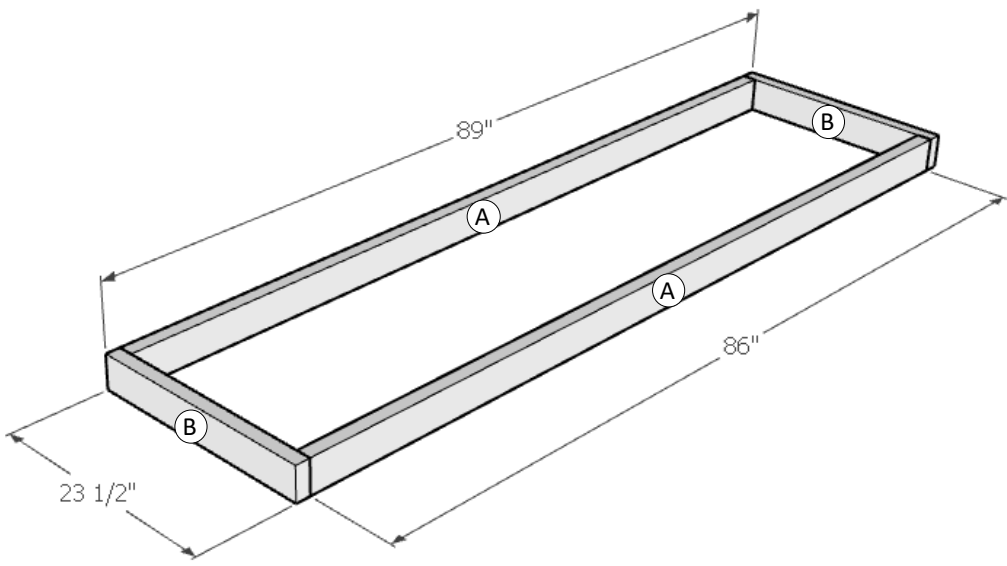
(5) 8' 2x4's (1-1/2" x 3-1/2" actual measurement)

(4) 8' 2X2'S (1-1/2" x 1-1/2" actual measurement)

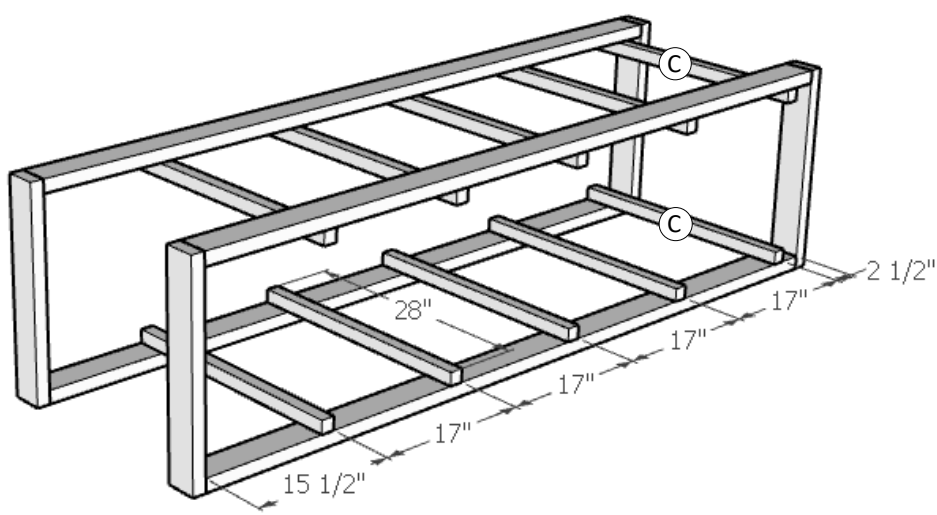


Build Instructions: *(Read all steps before starting)*

Step 1: Cut four frame legs (A) and four frame top/bottoms (B) to size. Put together one frame at a time using two legs and a top and bottom. Use two #10 2-1/2" screws at each joint.

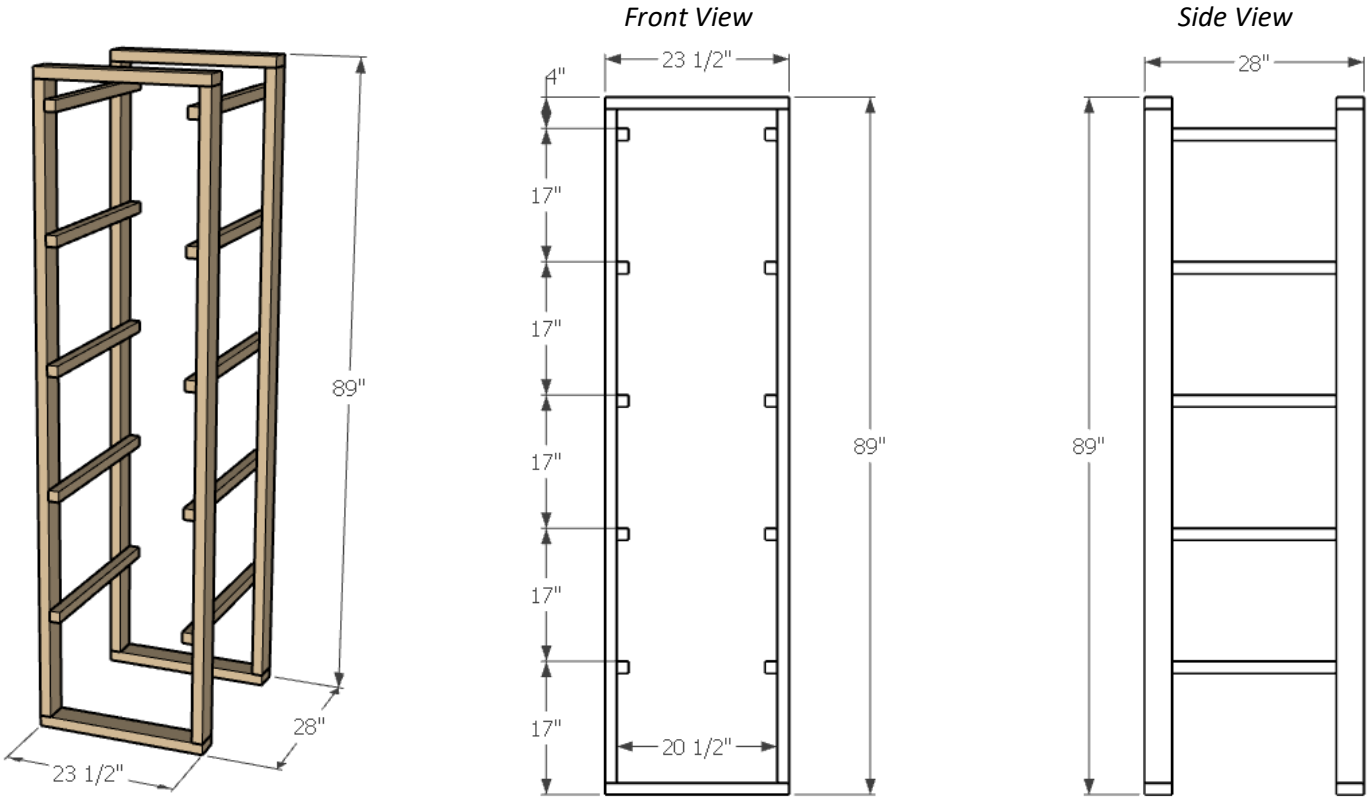


Step 2: Cut ten rails (C) to size. Attach the rails to the legs as seen. Make the front and back of legs flush with the outside of the frames. Secure with two screws at each joint.

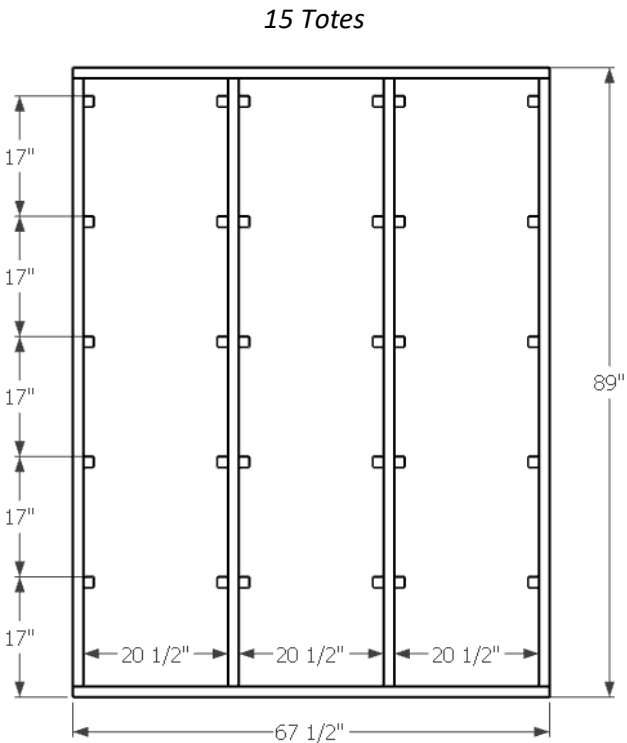
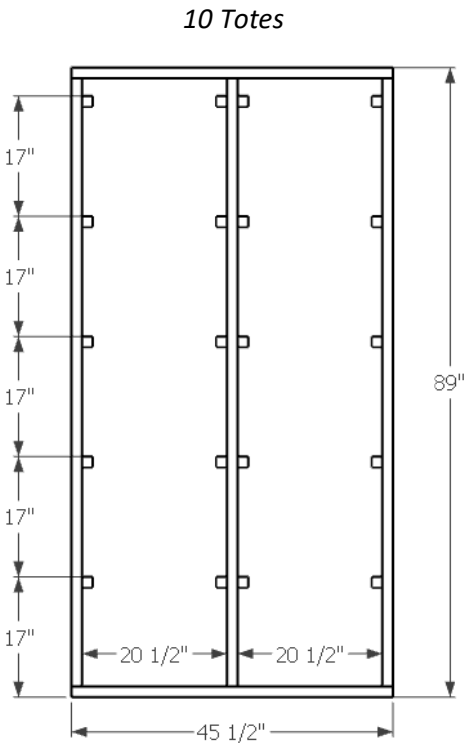


Build Instructions: *(Read all steps before starting)*

Step 3: Set upright and attach with screws to floor or wall to avoid a tipping hazard.



Note: You can expand the shelves as much as you want but adding 22" to the top and bottom pieces for each new column of totes.

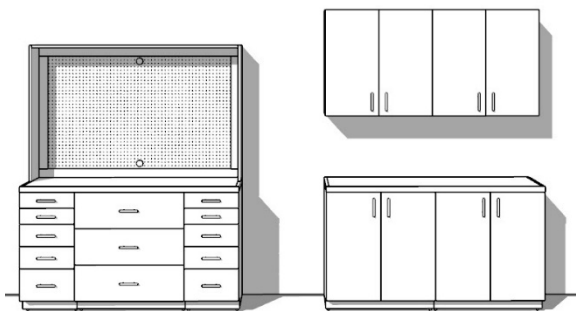
Tools Used

- Clamps

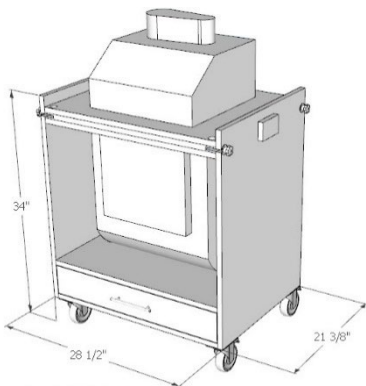
Materials/Supplies

- 2-1/2" #10 screws

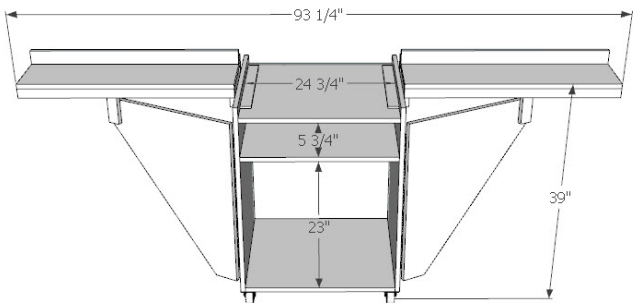
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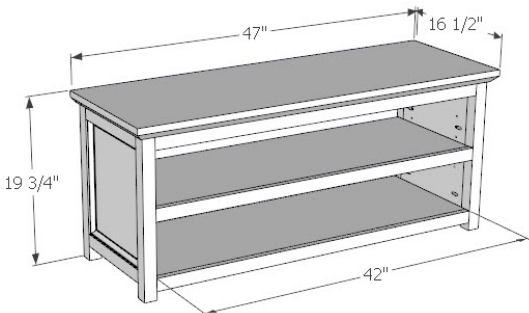
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
