Worksheet: Car Hire Website in JSFiddle

You will:

- Build a simple **car rental webpage** in JSFiddle
- Add pictures of different cars using image links
- Show three levels of cars as you go down the page

Part 1 – Make your car hire website in JSFiddle

1. Go to **<https://jsfiddle.net>**
2. Click the **Layout** icon and choose **Tabs**
3. Click the **HTML** tab
4. Delete anything already in the box
5. Copy this code exactly:

6. Click **Run** and check the **Result** tab to see your car hire website.

Part 2 – Add real car pictures

1. Open **Pixabay** or **Unsplash**
2. Search for: 'small car', 'family car', and 'sports car' or 'luxury car'
3. Right-click the image → Copy image address
4. Replace each image link in the HTML above with your copied link
5. Click **Run** again to view your images.

Part 3 – Improve your webpage

- Change the <title> to include your name.
- Add another car level (e.g. Electric Cars).
- Add a sentence under each level about who that car is best for.
- Experiment with simple colours using the CSS tab.

Check before finishing:

- Does your JSFiddle page show all three levels?
- Are your image links working?
- Is your layout neat and spelling correct?
