🔍 Go to [You.com/code](https://you.com/code) and search **#some description of your task** (adding a hashtag “#” in the front of your query primes the AI to generate code).

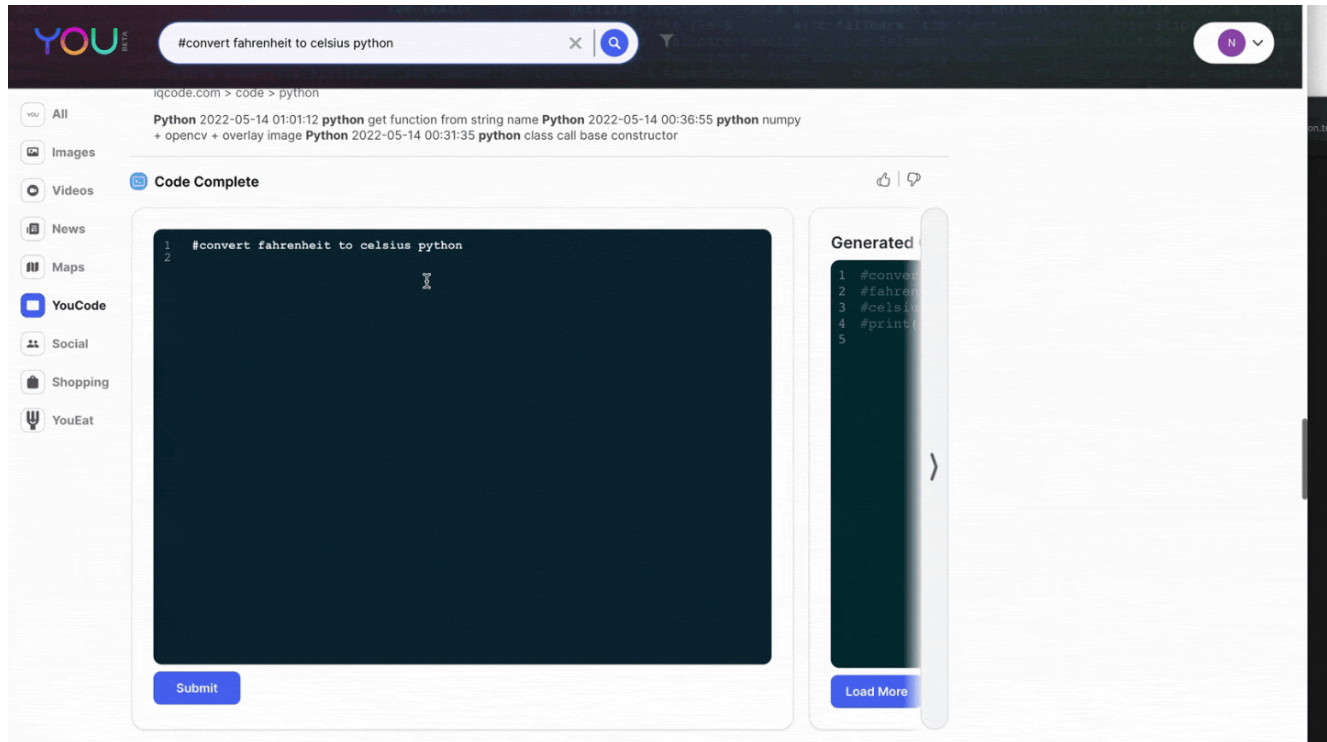
You can give it a function and some more structure, and AI will fill in the rest, helping you to crack that code.



Hit “submit” and watch the Code Complete AI generate the code in seconds!



Hit "load more" to see new code snippets.

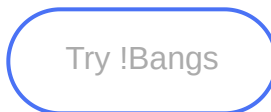
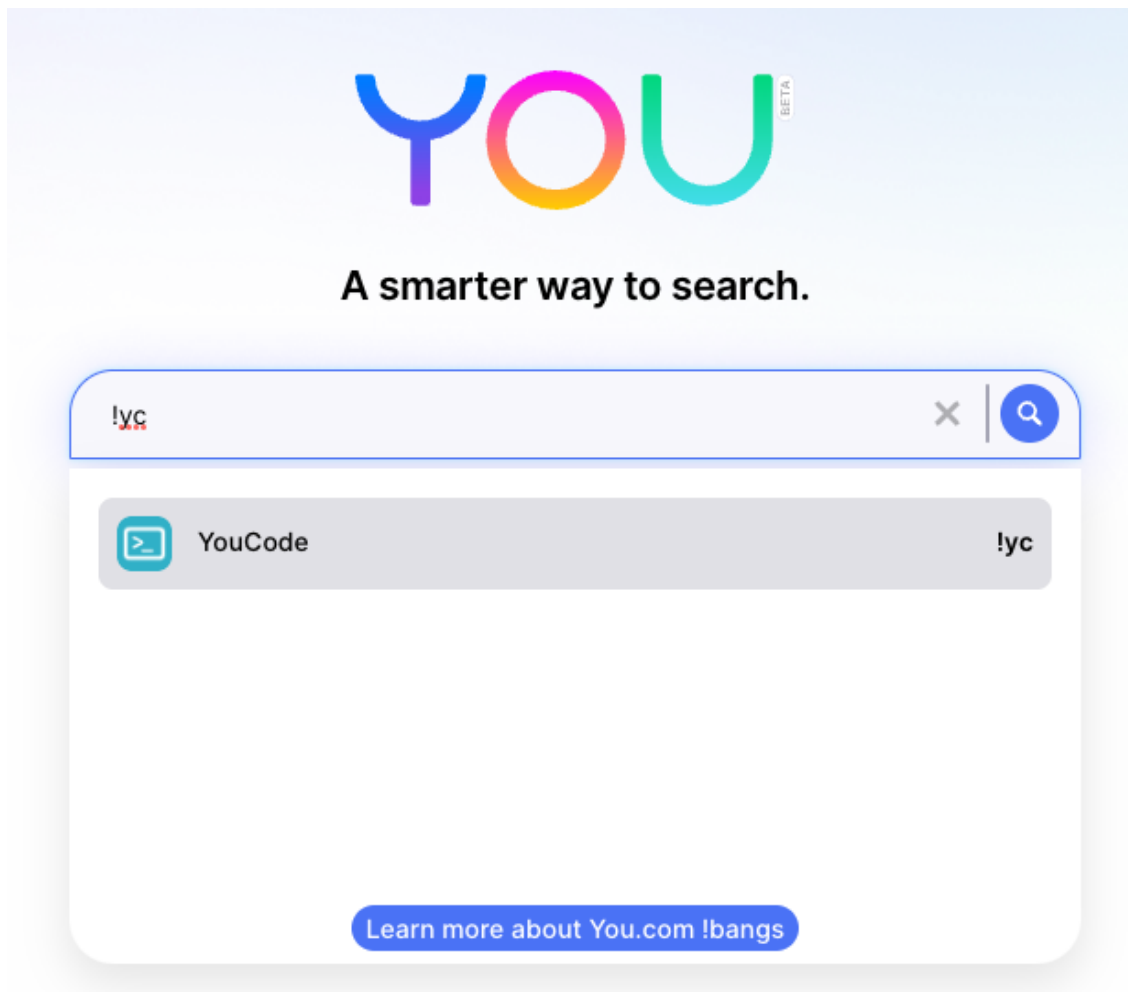
!Bangs

Use **!yc** bang to search on YouCode faster. To use !bangs, go to the search bar on [You.com](https://you.com), type the bang/exclamation mark (!) followed by a letter, combination of letters, the name of the site you want to search and with or without your query appended.

For example, typing “!yc CSS flexbox” will show you results for CSS flexbox on YouCode.

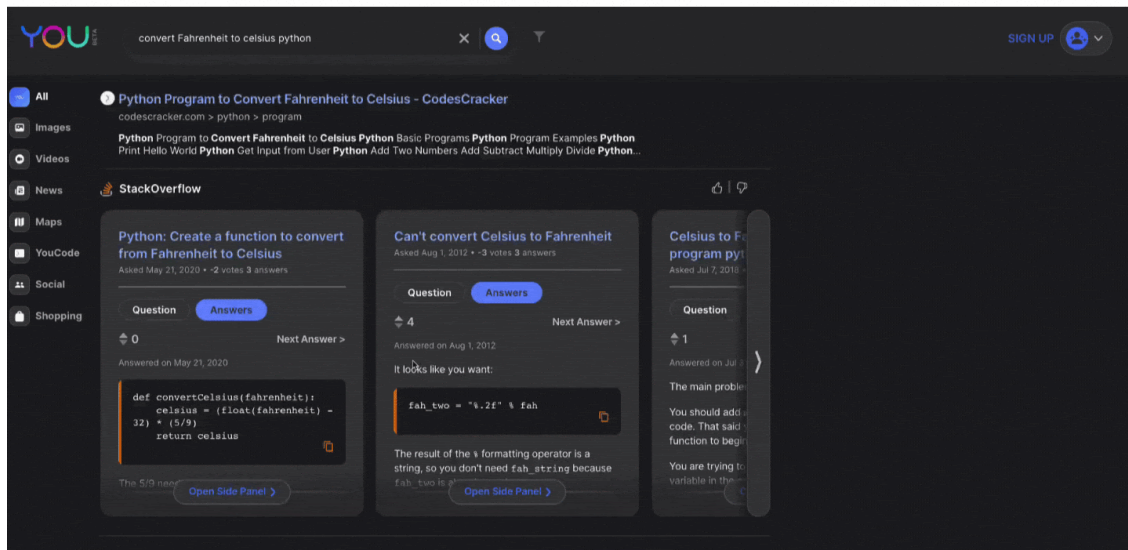
To use bangs in the address bar, you'll need to add [You.com](https://you.com) as your default.

There are more than 13,000 !bangs already in existence. You can look up the !bang for a specific site in the search bar by typing “!” followed by the site's name you'd like to search.

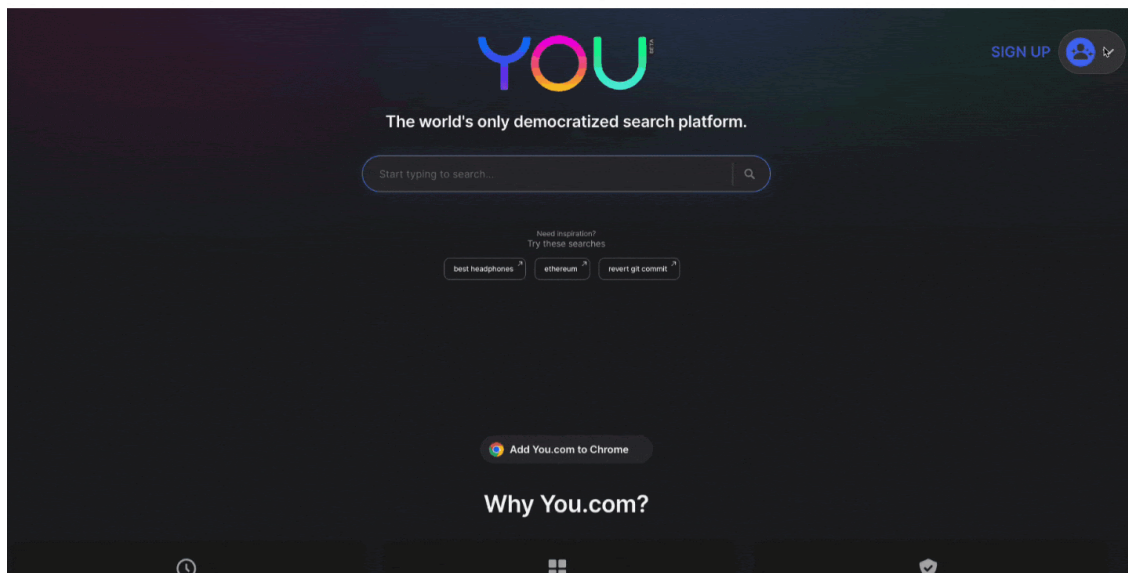

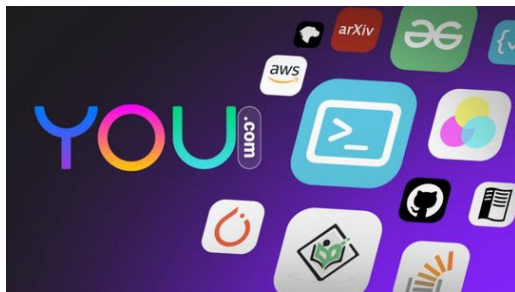

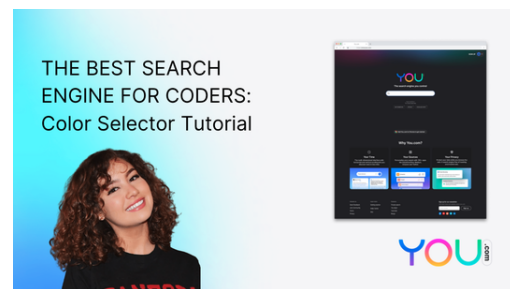
