The Creative Act

This is my interpretation of Rick Rubin's process as outlined in his AMAZING book "The Creative Act". There is much more in this book than is captured here. I highly recommend it.

1. Inspiration and Observation

- Being open and receptive to the world around you
- Collecting ideas, experiences, and observations that resonate
- Actions:
 - **Mind Mapping:** To make the most of your observations, try creating a mind map. Start with a central theme or question you're interested in. Then draw branches to record keywords, associated images, or other ideas it might bring to mind.
 - **Journaling:** Carry a small notebook or use a note-taking app on your phone and jot down things you find inspiring. It could be a snatch of overheard conversation, a piece of art, or even a mood you felt throughout a day. Don't edit yourself, just let it flow.

2. Capturing Seeds

- Recording and preserving the initial sparks of inspiration
- Identifying the core elements or essences of your ideas
- Actions:

Inspiration and Observation
